Parental Release

I, on behalf of myself and other parents and guardians of my child, hereby give permission for my child, _____, to participate in all youth group programs in Motor City USY (MCUSY), a partnership of Adat Shalom Synagogue, Congregation Beth Ahm, Congregation Beth Shalom, B'nai Israel Synagogue, Congregation B'nai Moshe, and Congregation Shaarey Zedek (collectively "Partner Synagogues"). In the event of injury or illness, I give permission for my child to be given first aid, medical, or dental treatment as deemed appropriate. In the event of an emergency, surgical or otherwise, I hereby give permission for my child to be transported to the nearest medical facility and specifically authorize a representative of MCUSY and/or the Partner Synagogues to select a physical and/or authorize medical treatment, including, without limitation, hospitalization, anesthesia, injection, and/or surgery measures which he/she feels are in the best interest of my child. I understand and acknowledge that I will be responsible for all expenses incurred on behalf of my child including, without limitation, medical bills incurred in connection with any transportation and treatment of my child.

Unless this space ____ is checked and I have provided you with specific instructions, directions, or other specific data to the contrary, on an attached page, I affirm that my child has no medical disabilities, allergies, or other limitations of any kind whatsoever that might in any way limit participation at any scheduled activity. If any medical disabilities, allergies, or other limitations have been identified, I hereby give MCUSY and/or the Partner Synagogues and its representatives authority to share this information with appropriate medical personnel.

I hereby release and hold harmless MCUSY and the Partner Synagogues, their officers, directors, employees, agents, and representatives from any and all claims, causes of action, judgements, awards, settlements, and/or damages to any person or property arising directly or indirectly of out of my child's participation in the program. I further release and hold harmless MCUSY and the Partner Synagogues, their officers, directors, employees, agents, and representatives from any and all claims, causes of action by reason of injury which may be sustained in connection with any program activity, regardless of location, or on the way to or from these activities, in connection with its selection of physician, medical treatment, hospital, or any other medical service for my child in a medical emergency, or in connection with the rendering of any such medical treatment, hospital, or any other medical service for my child in a medical emergency, or in connection with the rending of any such medical treatment.

I hereby grant permission for films, video and/or audio tape recordings, slides, and photographs (collectively "Media") to be taken of my child by MCUSY and/or Partner Synagogue personnel during MCUSY programs for purposes of promoting MCUSY. I authorize MCUSY and Partner Synagogues to use my child's image on its website and/or in other official synagogue/MCUSY publications without further consideration, and I acknowledge MCUSY and Partner Synagogues rights to crop or otherwise treat the Media at its discretion. I also understand that once my child's image is posted on the MCUSY website or other related websites, the image can be downloaded by any computer user.

I give permission for my child to attend programs which may include transportation such as airplane, train, bus and automobile. These programs will be announced in advance. I acknowledge and accept USY's policy to use licensed drivers over the age of 18 at all times, which may include volunteers or hired professionals. With full understanding of this policy and the risks involved, I give permission for my child to ride in a properly insured vehicle driven by a licensed driver over the age of 18.

MCUSY Code of Conduct

Section 1 – Behavior

1. Possession of drugs, alcohol, and cigarettes is not permitted at any MCUSY program.
2. Dietary laws, the Sabbath, and all other applicable Jewish laws in accordance with Conservative Jewish tradition must be observed at all its functions.
3. No one is permitted to leave any MCUSY program prior to its scheduled end without written parental permission turned into the chapter advisor prior to the program & approval of the advisor.
 - a. If there is anyone with whom your child should not leave, please notify the MCUSY advisor.
4. When attending a MCUSY program, we expect our members to respect each other, the staff, and volunteers.
 - a. Disrespect of your peers and leaders as well as other forms of unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated.
5. Vandalism of any kind will not be tolerated. Parents will be responsible for damages.
6. Stealing of any kind will not be tolerated.
7. Members are expected to maintain a positive attitude while at MCUSY events.
8. Cell phone usage is discouraged at programs.

Any violation of the above section could result in the removal of your child from the program and may jeopardize your child's ability to attend any future programs. If this occurs, there will be NO REFUNDS!

Section 2 –Regional and International Programs

In order for a Kadima or USY member to attend USY International Convention, Kadima Kinnus, or any USY Regional Event, they must meet the following guidelines:

1. Be a paid-up member of MCUSY
2. Have up-to-date emergency contact information on file
3. All event-specific fees, including registration and transportation, have been paid
